These schools function the same as other private schools that have incorporated and filed annual data base forms with the state. They keep files, transcripts and permanent records, issue credits, grant high school diplomas, require attendance records, issue parent/student handbooks and supply assistance in taking annual achievement tests, and college testing like the Scholastic Aptitude Test and the A.C.T. test as well as other testing necessary for admission to a college or university. Depending upon the schools requirements you do not have to be registered with the state as you are registered in a private school which is a great advantage over those families that are home schooling or (state registered).
