Graduation Requirements

A prescribed program (academic proscripton) leading to graduation must be established for each student at Florida Christian Academy. The program will vary, depending on such factors as the student's previous course of study, academic achievement, ability, and future plans such as does the student plan to go on to college after High School or does the student intend on preparing for a vocational career? When all essential information is received and factored into this equation then the administration will recommend a course of study for the student.

The program will be discussed with the Parent/Teacher for their final approval. At any rate the student must have completed twenty-four (24) high school credits to graduate from Florida Christian Academy. If the student is transferring in his senior year he must complete a minimum of six (6) high school credits through Florida Christian Academy before receiving a high school diploma regardless of how many credits the student may have earned before enrolling. The following are diploma programs a student pursue.

Students who are capable should follow the [COLLEGE PREPARATORY COURSE OF ACADEMIC STUDIES](#). Some qualified students will choose to pursue a less demanding academic program and take the [GENERAL EDUCATION COURSE \(CAREER\) OF ACADEMIC STUDIES](#) insisting that they have no plans to ever enroll in college. However, these students frequently change their minds and then regret not having prepared themselves better for college.
